A grade of C or higher is required for all INFO prerequisites and co-requisites. A grade of D is acceptable in courses from the GELO requirements. If you do not successfully complete certain courses as listed in the sequencing, it may take additional terms to complete the degree.

"Advisor approved elective" can be any INFO course (except INFO1005) not listed as a requirement in the focus.
